WHEREAS, In these capacities, Sara Niccoli fought for the creation of good local jobs, a strong social safety net, affordable housing, and restorative justice models; and

WHEREAS, Guided by faith, Sara Niccoli is an active member of Trinity Lutheran Church in Stone Arabia; she serves on the Executive Committee of the New York State Council of Churches, and is a member of the New York Yearly Meeting of the Society of Friends (Quakers); and

WHEREAS, In addition, she is Town Supervisor in Palatine and a member of the Montgomery County Planning Board; and

WHEREAS, With her throughout have been her husband, Sean, and their daughter, Olive, both of whom feel privileged to be a part of her life and rejoice in her achievements; and

WHEREAS, For the past six years, Sara Niccoli rendered faithful, conscientious and valuable service to the Labor-Religion Coalition of New York State, earning her the admiration, esteem and affection of her

colleagues; now, therefore, be it
