COMMENDING Sophie Kartzman upon the occasion of her designation as a Distinguished Finalist in the 22nd Annual Prudential Spirit of Community Awards program

WHEREAS, The success of the State of New York, the strength of our communities, and the vitality of American society depend, in great measure, upon the dedication of young people like Sophie Kartzman, who use their considerable talents and resources to serve others; and
