All donations will go to Long Island Cares' Baxter's Pet Pantry, which assists families who are having difficulty feeding their pets so that those animals can remain in their homes instead of a shelter.

Residents interested in participating in the pet food drive can donate the following items:

- · 5 or 10 pound bags of dog and cat food;
- · Canned dog and cat food;
- · Food for all pets, including but not limited to reptiles, fish, ferrets and hamsters;

- · Treats;
- · Kitty Litter;
- · Pet toys (new and unused only).

All pet food must be unopened and in its original packaging. Opened bags, ripped bags or loose pet food cannot be accepted.
