WHEREAS, The athletic talent displayed by this team is a reflection of the tireless efforts of Coaches Scott Rush, Joe Mancini and Joe Hopko, skilled and inspirational mentors, respected for their ability to encourage young athletes and develop potential into excellence; and

WHEREAS, The players and coaches were loyally and enthusiastically supported by family, friends, and fans while igniting pride over the entire community; and

WHEREAS, The hallmarks of the Maine-Endwell Little League Team, from the opening game of the season to participation in the World Championship, were a brotherhood of athletic ability, of good sportsmanship, of honor and of integrity, demonstrating that these team players are second to none; and

WHEREAS, The talented members of the Maine-Endwell Little League Team have proven themselves to be an unbeatable combination of talents, reflecting favorably on not only their community, but also the State and Nation as a whole; and
