

New York State Veterans Awards

New York State offers several military awards to veterans who currently live in New York State or who were New York State residents at the time of their military service, including:

New York State Conspicuous Service Cross

New York State Medal for Merit

New York State Conspicuous Service Star

New York State Cold War Certificate

Eligibility for these awards is based on the applicant's military service record. Click the award names above to view the respective eligibility criteria and obtain applications.

These medals can be awarded posthumously to the family of a deceased veteran.
