HONORING Richard Jerome upon the occasion of his designation as recipient of the Rodney Lightfoote Agricultural Viability and Innovation Award

WHEREAS, In addition, Rich Jerome provides a portion of his grapes for wine, and to the local pie makers in Naples; and

WHEREAS, With a steadfast and unwavering commitment to his community, Rich Jerome has served as a Board member of the Cornell Cooperative Extension, Chairman of the NYFB Grape Advisory Committee, Director of NYFB District III, and Board member and President of the Ontario County Farm Bureau; and

WHEREAS, Rich Jerome has also been a member of the Ontario County Ag Enhancement Board, Naples Planning Board, and Naples School Board; and

WHEREAS, With him throughout have been his wife, Mary, and their three children, as well as six grandchildren, all of whom feel privileged to be a part of his life and rejoice in his achievements; and

WHEREAS, It is incumbent upon all citizens to recognize and applaud the efforts of individuals such as Rich Jerome who work tirelessly on behalf of protecting and promoting our natural surroundings for the benefit of present and future generations of New Yorkers; now,
