Albany, NY - Late Friday afternoon the New York State Legislature called it a day after last minute negotiations fell apart to approve the State's \$152 billion budget making a late budget imminent. While lawmakers are expected to work through the weekend, State Senator Terrence Murphy said the following:

"It is very disappointing that we failed to pass an on time budget. We have a responsibility to those we represent to pass one of the largest budgets in the world. In fact, we should be passing our budgets early."
