WHEREAS, A freshman at Chapel Field High School, James Patrick
Monahan participates in the junior varsity baseball team and the concert
band; a musician for the New York State Volunteers Civil War Reenactors,
he has participated in numerous Living History programs in Orange
County, New York, and Gettysburg, Pennsylvania; and

WHEREAS, America has achieved her greatest heights of glory through the dedication, determination and tireless efforts of the outstanding citizens of this Nation; and

WHEREAS, It is only with the continued diligence and devotion of our

youth, tomorrow's leaders, that America will maintain her glory; and
