All nominations are due by May 1st, which begins National Military Appreciation Month.

In recent years, Senator Ritchie has honored dozens of local veterans through the Veterans Hall of Fame initiative. Individuals recognized have included those who have fought in some of history's most dangerous battles, including, the Invasion of Normandy, Iwo Jima and the Battle of the Bulge, as well as more recent conflicts in Vietnam, Iraq and Afghanistan.
