WHEREAS, Our country's volunteer force of over 63 million is a great treasure; those who volunteer play a vital role in our community and our future as a caring and productive nation; and

WHEREAS, The State of New York should help encourage volunteerism and the spirit of giving during National Volunteer Week, so that a greater call to action can encourage residents to spread the philanthropic spirit; now, therefore, be it
