WHEREAS, Upon the completion of her military service, Dr. Lauren S. Roman became the Chief Medical Officer for River Hospital in Alexandria Bay, New York, where she also practiced Family Medicine; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Lauren S. Roman is currently a member of the American Academy of Family Physicians and the American Association for Physician Leadership; and
