WHEREAS, Poised eagerly with enthusiasm and determined purpose, Christina Drakeford now stands honorably, with just pride in her accomplishments and in eager anticipation of future challenges, understanding and appreciating the caring counsel and inspiration provided by Laura Howse of Kenmore West High School; and

WHEREAS, It is the sense of this Legislative Body that when young people of such noble aims and accomplishments are brought to our attention, they should be celebrated and recognized by all the citizens of the great State of New York; now, therefore, be it
