State Senator Patty Ritchie will host 10th Mountain Division and Fort Drum Day at the State Capitol on Tuesday, May 2nd.

This will be the sixth straight year Senator Ritchie has highlighted the brave men and women of the Division through the event. In addition to paying tribute to their sacrifices, it will also shine a spotlight on the significant impact Fort Drum has on the region's—as well as the state's—economy.

In addition, the day will also feature a number of interactive displays manned by troops, as well as those highlighting community groups integral to the relationship between Fort Drum and the North Country's civilian community.
