WHEREAS, The Robert W. Carbonaro School Student Council has raised significant funds for numerous worthy organizations including the Ronald McDonald House of Long Island, "Pennies for Patients", which benefitted children battling leukemia and lymphoma, and monthly fundraisers which assist needy families and to raise money for its scholarship to a South High School graduating senior who started their education at the Robert W. Carbonaro School; and

WHEREAS, In addition, the Student Council organized a school-wide carnival and created a school store to help raise funds for upcoming events, and collected food for families in the area as well as for Island Harvest; and
