Ed Babor enlisted in the United States Army in May 1960. He served prior to the Vietnam War for six years with the Army National Guard, and was honorably discharged with the rank of Sergeant. Mr. Babor trained annually at Fort Drum in Upstate New York and received basic training at Fort Dix in New Jersey. Additionally, he received basic and advanced artillery training at Fort Sill, Oklahoma.

Mr. Babor's time in the military paved the road for his successful career. He became a business owner in the automotive industry, with 30 years of service as a Senior Inspector

with the New York State Department of Motor Vehicles. He is currently Queens
Representative for Congresswoman Carolyn B. Maloney. Mr. Babor believes in helping others
through his involvement, commitment and volunteerism in the community.
