WHEREAS, Michael Watts also founded and held various leadership positions at several student organizations on campus including President of GoldenKey, the chess club, Vice President of Pi Sigma Alpha Political Science Honor Society, a writer for Her Campus, Program Director for the San Kofa Africa organization, and a Student Association Elections Commissioner; and

WHEREAS, Michael Watts interned for the 90th Assembly District, and the 42nd Assembly District; most recently, he participated in the Selective Undergraduate State-Senate Program with the 14th District; in
