Ritchie: Over \$450,000 Awarded to Improve Local Libraries

State Senator Patty Ritchie is announcing that libraries throughout Central and Northern New York will receive more than \$450,000 in public library construction funds to make upgrades to their facilities.

Funding announced today is part of a \$19 million capital fund appropriation in the 2016 State Budget for construction and renovation of public libraries and public library systems in New York State. Funding awarded in Senator Ritchie's district will allow ten libraries to enhance energy efficiency, make infrastructure improvements, improve handicapped accessibility

and more.

“The libraries in our region do an excellent job of connecting people with endless opportunities for learning, growth and culture,” said Senator Ritchie, who serves as Chair of the Senate Select Committee on Libraries. “I am pleased that through this funding, our local libraries will be able to continue to improve their services for patrons.”
