

Ritchie Commends St. Lawrence County Drug Task Force In Sweeping Raid

State Senator Patty Ritchie is applauding the work by the St. Lawrence County Drug Task Force for their role in a massive drug bust that saw more than 100 people arrested.

The investigation, which had been ongoing since August 2016, identified individuals from St. Lawrence County, Syracuse, New York City, Buffalo and New Jersey as having a role in this drug ring, which involved heroin and cocaine.

"Combating the drug epidemic is tough and requires a multi-pronged approach," said Senator Ritchie, who serves as a member of the Senate's Joint Task Force on Heroin and Opioid Addiction.
