

Ritchie To Co-Host "Dairy Day" At State Capitol

Senate Agriculture Committee Chair Patty Ritchie is inviting the public and agriculture professionals from across the region and state to attend "Dairy Day" at the State Capitol.

The event—which is being held in "The Well" of the Legislative Office Building from 10:30 a.m. until 1:00 p.m.—is a celebration of the New York dairy industry. Numerous vendors will be on hand offering free samples of their products and showcasing their services to dairy farmers.

This is the second consecutive year that Senator Ritchie has co-sponsored this event with the Chair of the Assembly Agriculture Committee, Bill Magee.
