

Senator Bonacic Secures \$50,000 for Safe Homes of Orange County

(Middletown, NY)- State Senator John J. Bonacic (R/C/I-Mt. Hope) announced today that he has secured \$50,000 for Safe Homes of Orange County. The money for Safe Homes is part of a larger pot of funding made available in the FY 2017-2018 State Budget (Chapter 53 of 2017), which was approved earlier this year. The specific money for Safe Homes was allocated in a resolution at the end of the legislative session. The \$50,000 will be used for programs that prevent domestic violence and aid victims of domestic violence.

"I have always been a strong supporter of the great work being done by Safe Homes of Orange County," said Senator Bonacic. "I am pleased to secure this funding for Safe Homes because I know they will use it positively in the ongoing battle to end the scourge of domestic violence."
