Watkins Glen, N.Y., August 3—State Senator Tom O'Mara (R,C,I-Big Flats) and Assemblyman Phil Palmesano (R,C,I-Corning) released the following statement after today's announcement that Watkins Glen International was victorious in *USA Today's* online competition to decide America's **''Best NASCAR Track''**:

The nearly month-long *USA Today* voting contest ended on Monday, July 23. WGI was among 20 nationwide finalists for the 2018 designation. This year marks the third consecutive year that The Glen has won the "Best NASCAR Track" honor.

Throughout the competition, O'Mara, Palmesano, and other local leaders singled out The Glen for its unique contributions to American motorsports. WGI events annually generate over \$200 million in economic activity across the region and account for more than 2,000 local jobs. The NASCAR Sprint Cup Series weekend in August is one of New York's largest sporting events and attracts fans from all 50 states, as well as 16 different countries.
