

Ritchie Delivers \$64,000 in Funding to Improve Public Safety in St. Lawrence County

In an effort to improve public safety in the North Country, State Senator Patty Ritchie is announcing she has secured \$64,000 in special funding that will help support the St.

Lawrence County Sheriff's Department and numerous county fire departments.

Funds secured by Senator Ritchie will help the St. Lawrence County Sheriff's Department with crime control and prevention programs. In addition, they will also help nearly 20 different fire departments make upgrades to their facilities and purchase equipment that

will allow them to respond to emergencies.

"They risk so much to keep us safe and that's why it's imperative that we are there to support them. I am pleased to provide this funding, which will help our responders not only be more prepared when going into harm's way, but be better protected."
