

Senator Bonacic Announces \$100,000 Grant for SUNY Delhi

(Middletown, NY)- State Senator John J. Bonacic (R/C/I-Mt. Hope) announced today that SUNY Delhi has been awarded a \$100,000 grant for the purchase of equipment for the college's mechatronics design program. The grant was secured through the State and Municipal Facilities Program, funding for which was appropriated in the 2017-2018 State Budget.

SUNY Delhi has identified applied learning as the college's unique niche in higher education.

Applied learning prepares technicians for immediate employment. At SUNY Delhi, the

greatest number of applied learning opportunities take place in the college's School of Technology, through programs ranging from Construction Management to Integrated Energy Systems and from Mechatronics to Welding.
