

The Bronx Civic Center Receives \$10 Million for Revitalization

Senator Serrano joined his colleagues and Governor Cuomo in announcing the Bronx Civic Center neighborhood in the South Bronx will receive \$10 million in funding and investments as the New York City winner of the second round of the Downtown Revitalization Initiative. As in the first round of the DRI, one downtown from each of the state's 10 regional economic development regions will be selected as that region's DRI winner and will benefit from \$10 million in state investment to revitalize the area, marking another overall state goal to target \$100 million in funding and investments to help communities identify catalytic downtown

projects to boost the local economy.
