Yorktown, NY - Over 400 road racing enthusiasts braved the brisk morning air to participate in Senator Terrence Murphy's Inaugural Hudson Valley Turkey Trot. The 5k race, held early Thanksgiving morning, was organized to benefit two local food pantries - St. Mary's of Mohegan Lake and St. John's of Mahopac.

"We were very pleasantly surprised by the overwhelming response from our community. It

comforting to know that people are willing to come out on Thanksgiving to help families who are less fortunate," said Senator Murphy. "I am confident the Turkey Trot will continue to attract racers to Yorktown for many years to come."

The race started on Front Street and continued along Route 118, finishing back at Front Street. Darren Schiminski of Montrose was the first to cross the finish line. The top male division runner set a blistering pace with a time of 18:31. Kaitlyn DiBello topped the female division with a rapid run of 20:18.
