In Dutchess County, these drives include:

- **Food Drive**—*The winter weather too often makes it challenging for seniors to get the resources they need. Help make the holidays a little brighter for area seniors by donating non-perishable food items to be distributed to local, low-income senior housing communities—December 1<sup>st</sup>-18<sup>th</sup>; Drop Off*
