Rose tirelessly treated more than 60 wounded in his unit while behind enemy lines, without regard to his own personal safety and even after being hit by shrapnel; he is credited with saving many lives; and

WHEREAS, Gary M. Rose went on to serve his country for 20 years, achieving the esteemed rank of Army captain; and

WHEREAS, Gary M. Rose was honored for his bravery by President Donald J. Trump in a ceremony at the White House on Monday, October 23, 2017, with other members of his Army unit in attendance as well as his two grandchildren, and was lauded for his heroism and meritorious service to his beloved country; and

WHEREAS, Residents of this great State must never forget the courage with which men and women like Gary M. Rose served their country; and

WHEREAS, Having exhibited his unwavering patriotism, Gary M. Rose demonstrated his love for his country and merits forevermore, the highest respect of this State and Nation; and

WHEREAS, Our Nation's veterans deserve to be recognized, commended and thanked by the people of the State of New York for their service and for their dedication to their communities, and their Nation; now, therefore, be it
