WHEREAS, Dale Moser has enjoyed years of educating the public on the maple industry through television appearances and radio stints; in addition, he conducts tours of his maple sugarhouse and has participated in the Lewis County Conservation Field Days for the past seven years, educating nearly 120 sixth graders; and
