WHEREAS, On Saturday, January 6, 2018, Canandaigua Fire Captain Don Philips responded to reports of a structure fire with people trapped; and

WHEREAS, Upon arriving on the scene, Firefighter Captain Don Philips observed thick black smoke pouring from an apartment at Camelot Court; and

WHEREAS, Without hesitation or regard for his own safety, Captain Don Philips, who couldn't see anything, crawled through the apartment feeling around for the victim, a quadriplegic who requires a motorized wheelchair; and

WHEREAS, This brave firefighter was able to locate both the woman and her dog within two minutes of searching the smoke filled home, carrying them both out the window to safety; and

WHEREAS, Furthermore, immediately after the rescue, Firefighter

Captain Don Philips remarkably began to extinguish the fire as no other

firefighters had yet arrived on the scene; and

WHEREAS, Captain Don Philips should be regarded as a true hero; he has continually devoted himself to public service, demonstrating great courage and diligence in providing for the care and welfare of the citizens of this great Empire State; and

WHEREAS, Praised for maintaining his composure and his professional conduct, Captain Don Philips demonstrated his true character and genuine compassion for the well-being of others; and

WHEREAS, Within every community of the State of New York there are certain individuals who, by virtue of their commitment and dedication,

command the respect and admiration of their community for their exemplary contributions and service on behalf of others; Captain Don Philips is one such individual; and
