WHEREAS, In addition, this esteemed man served for many years as priest at Historic St. Mary's Church on Capitol Hill in Albany, New York, and was appointed to the Albany County Ethics Commission in 2016; and

WHEREAS, A friend, mentor, storyteller, and a part of the fabric which makes Albany a special place to live and work, Father James Lefebvre's impression will be felt for many years to come by those who were fortunate enough to come in contact with him; and

WHEREAS, Father James Lefebvre will be fondly remembered for his commitment to serving the residents of this city; his humor, quick wit and smile will be deeply missed; and

WHEREAS, Armed with a humanistic spirit and imbued with a sense of compassion, Father James Lefebvre leaves behind a legacy which will long endure the passage of time and will remain as a comforting memory to all he served and befriended; now, therefore, be it
