WHEREAS, Rare indeed is the impressive dedication shown by an individual for the benefit of others which Eugene Bettiol, Sr. has displayed throughout his life; and

WHEREAS, It has always been the objective of this Legislative Body to honor and support those individuals who displayed their commitment to the betterment of their communities, and it is the intent of this Legislative Body to inscribe upon its records, this posthumous tribute to Eugene Bettiol, Sr., that future generations may know and appreciate his admirable character, his many benevolent deeds, and the respect and esteem in which he was held by his peers; now, therefore, be it
