WHEREAS, Rebecca Joseph is a regular participant in SPARC, a program which brings urban and suburban high school students together to complete a service project each month; this kind and compassionate young woman also assists eighth grade students in various service activities; and

WHEREAS, Rebecca Joseph is a credit to her family, school, community, and her State and Nation, and it is certain that her future will be filled with accomplishments of equal importance; and

WHEREAS, With her sense of civic duty and her commitment to others, Rebecca Joseph represents the best development of the potential which is inherent in our most precious resource, our youth; now, therefore, be it
