CONGRATULATING Jessica Curtis upon the occasion of her induction into the Port Jervis School District Alumni Hall of Fame on October 8, 2017

WHEREAS, Throughout the entire period of her professional and community service, a period of constructive involvement, Jessica Curtis stood constant in dignity, good grace and humor; and

WHEREAS, It is the sense of this Legislative Body that those individuals who enhanced the well-being and vitality of their community and demonstrated a long and sustained commitment to excellence certainly have earned the recognition and applause of all the citizens of this great Empire State; now, therefore, be it
