Community Board 7, where he ensured public and private projects addressed the community's needs and revitalized the local economy, including the Kingsbridge National Ice Center, the Jerome Park Reservoir, and the Mosholu Parkway; and

WHEREAS, Andrew Sandler was a steadfast public servant to the Northwest Bronx community serving at the most local levels of government; and

WHEREAS, Andrew Sandler became an advocate for cancer patients to help New Yorkers battling cancer get the care they need; and

WHEREAS, Andrew Sandler was relentless in his desire to remedy issues facing his community, no matter how big or small, and served as an inspiration for all public servants in the Northwest Bronx; and

WHEREAS, It is the sense of this Legislative Body to convey its appreciation to a community leader who dedicated his life and career in faithful service to his Bronx community and its heartfelt regret that he left us at such a young age; now, therefore, be it
