WHEREAS, Known for its cleanliness and order, Dominic Condino Motors Inc. has flourished under the hard work and dedication of three generations of Condinos; and

WHEREAS, Now operated by Dominic's grandson, James D. Condino, the business has seen many third generation customers, who join with the Village of Carthage in celebrating the success of Dominic Condino Motors Inc.; and
