WHEREAS, John Douveas is a member of Boy Scouts of America Troop 268, Flushing, New York; and

WHEREAS, A 15 year-old Freshman at Francis Lewis High School, John Douveas is a member of both the Varsity Wrestling Team and Varsity Volleyball Team; he also serves as a Freshman Representative in the Student Government Organization; and

WHEREAS, Furthermore, in 2017, this extraordinary young man earned a first degree Black Belt in Taekwondo after 8 years of training; and

WHEREAS, John Douveas began participating in the scouting program as a 6-year-old Tiger cub at the St. Nicholas Greek Orthodox Church in Flushing, New York; after completing the requirements of the program and

WHEREAS, Active in his community, John Douveas gives of his time and energies to the annual St. Nicholas Church Festival and as a volunteer office assistant with St. Nicholas Greek Orthodox Church Sunday school program; and

WHEREAS, In addition, he has participated in countless local beautification projects and blood drives; and

WHEREAS, America has achieved her greatest heights of glory through the dedication, determination and tireless efforts of the outstanding citizens of this Nation; and

WHEREAS, It is only with the continued diligence and devotion of our youth, tomorrow's leaders, that America will maintain her glory; and

WHEREAS, The Boy Scouts of America and its members are dedicated to the development of character and leadership in the youth of this Nation; and

WHEREAS, The highest achievement of leadership in Scouting, earned by only five percent of all Boy Scouts, is the distinguished rank of Eagle Scout; and

WHEREAS, His dedication to the safety and well-being of the citizens of Flushing, New York, is represented through his project and demonstrates his devotion to both community and commitment to others; and

WHEREAS, John Douveas' perseverance in rising through the ranks to Eagle Scout is a strong indication of his ability to master difficult tasks; his accomplishment will enable him to emerge as a leader, fully equipped to meet the challenges of today's complex society; and
