MEMORIALIZING Governor Andrew M. Cuomo to proclaim October 2018, as the Disability Employment Awareness Month in the State of New York

WHEREAS, Not only does working bring about value and independence to disabled individuals, but hiring disabled individuals enhances corporate social responsibility and promotes diversity in the workplace; and

WHEREAS, New Yorkers with disabilities, like all New Yorkers, are entitled to not only full participation in our society, but also full opportunity in our society; their talents and contributions are vital to the strength of our State's workforce and our future prosperity; and

WHEREAS, Together, we can ensure persons living with disabilities have equal access to employment, and to an inclusive, supportive workplace; and

WHEREAS, It is in the interest of New York State to recognize the achievements which have been made thus far, and to continue these efforts by promoting the awareness and fostering the understanding of persons with disabilities; now, therefore, be it
