COMMEMORATING Brooklyn, New York's 5th Annual

WHEREAS, Brooklyn Borough President, Eric L. Adams, has diligently worked to build One Brooklyn by bridging gaps between cultures and forging bonds of friendship which connect people in every community throughout the world, while promoting worldwide peace and unity in Brooklyn and beyond; and
