Elmira, N.Y., August 16—Entering the final weekend of voting, State Senator Tom O'Mara (R,C,I-Big Flats) and Assemblyman Phil Palmesano (R,C,I-Corning) reminded area residents to keep voting every day for the Finger Lakes in USA Today's 10 Best online Readers' Choice competition to decide America's "Best Wine Region."
