Senator Serrano partnered with Governor Cuomo to sponsor an Emergency Preparedness
Trainings at the High Bridge Senior Center in the Bronx. Led by Governor Cuomo's Citizen
Preparedness Corps, the two-hour training provided an overview of how to respond to
natural or man-made disasters. Participants were advised on developing a family emergency
plan, stocking up on emergency supplies, and how to build and maintain a supply kit that
will keep loved ones safe in an emergency. The event was co-sponsored by Congressman Jose
E. Serrano, Assembly Member Latoya Joyner, and Council Member Vanessa Gibson. All

participants received a Citizen Preparedness Corps Starter Kit backpack.
