WHEREAS, The Artie Awards Ceremony is a benefit, with all proceeds from the evening going to an HIV/AIDS related charity; and

WHEREAS, Jeffrey Coyle won the 2018 Artie Award for Outstanding Supporting Actor in a Musical for his superlative performance in The Full Monty; and

WHEREAS, This Legislative Body recognizes the importance of the performing arts, which act to inspire, enlighten, and unify people from all cultural backgrounds through the transcendent power of human expression; and

WHEREAS, It is most fitting that we take time to celebrate the arts of our Nation, to honor our artists, and to express our appreciation to everyone who patronizes the arts; and as we celebrate the arts, we celebrate and give thanks to our American freedom, the only atmosphere in which artists can truly create and in which art is truly the expression of the soul; now, therefore, be it
