Mr. Kozloski, who originally hailed from Mahopac, was a member of the Coast Guard Cutter Hickey and served his country admirably for over 17 years. His devotion to duty and public service defending our nation will never be forgotten. His family, friends and members of his unit will be in our thoughts and prayers. Let us never forget the sacrifices the members of the military make defending our freedom."
