The event will be held at Canarsie Park on Seaview Ave, Brooklyn, NY 11236 at the East 88th St entrance from 11 a.m. to 1 p.m. There will be games and activities for the families and children as well as light refreshments, free giveaways and a special visit from the Easter Bunny. Entry is free but families are asked to bring a basket for each child; and all children must be accompanied by an adult.


Last year's event featured many sponsors, vendors and volunteers and turned out a huge success with hundreds in attendance. The children collected over 1,500 colored eggs filled with candy and five lucky kids found golden eggs with special prizes — four gift cards for school uniforms from S&D Kids and one \$40 gift card. The families enjoyed activities such as face painting and balloon making and Senator Persaud actively passed out bags of goodies and encouraged attendees to meet the Easter Bunny.
