The O’Mara-Palmesano proclamation ([J1057/K264](#)), unanimously approved by the Senate and Assembly, reads, in part, “It is the custom of this Legislative Body to recognize and pay tribute to those young people within the State of New York who, by achieving outstanding success in athletic competition, have inspired and brought pride to their school and community...In a sport such as the triple jump, which demands athletic prowess, speed and agility, Coaches Scott Shepardson, Joe Hober and Dennis Jemison worked hard to hone the skills of this champion, teaching this outstanding athlete lessons which will prove invaluable both in and out of the pit. In light of her recent accomplishments, Lily Hall has brought honor and just pride to her club, school and community on the local, State and National level.”
