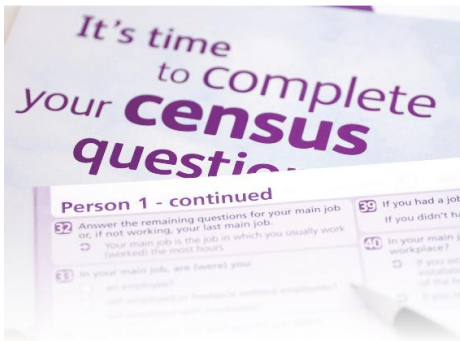

WHAT IS THE 2020 CENSUS?

The census is a government survey conducted once every ten years that counts the population of the United States and gathers valuable statistics that can be used toward the long-term improvement of our nation. The next census will be conducted **starting April 1, 2020**, and it is important that as many New Yorkers as possible complete it.

WHY DOES IT MATTER?

- The results of the census determine how much federal funding a state gets, distributed from over \$675 billion annually. The more New Yorkers fill out the census, the more funding we get!
- The census determines how many congressional seats and electoral votes a state is afforded. The more New Yorkers fill out the census, the better represented we will be!
