ISSUE: QUEENS BUS NETWORK REDESIGN, BUSES, NEW YORK CITY TRANSIT, MTA



ASTORIA, N.Y. – Senate Deputy Leader Michael Gianaris sent a letter to the Metropolitan Transportation Authority (MTA) calling on the agency to focus on three main issues presented by their proposed Queens Bus Network redesign: accessibility problems, difficult transfers, and lack of access to cultural institutions.

"Queens riders depend on the reliability and accessibility of our buses to get around.

Redesigning the system cannot be a code for cuts and greater inconvenience to thousands of

riders," said **Senate Deputy Leader Michael Gianaris.** "I urge the MTA to work on these major issues and help improve buses for everyone in our neighborhoods."
