


An Important Message from Senator Ritchie to St. Lawrence Co. Residents

Dear St. Lawrence County Residents,

I am writing with a critical message I was asked to share. Earlier today, the St. Lawrence
County Sheriff's Department issued a Travel Restriction Advisory for the County. Through
this advisory, residents are asked to refrain from all non-essential travel until further notice.

The advisory notes that we are in a very critical juncture in the fight against COVID-19, with all the models suggesting that if we do not practice social distancing and limit non-essential

travel and gatherings, the consequences could be dire.
