## How to Vote Absentee

| ISSUE: **CORONAVIRUS PANDEMIC, COVID-19; ABSENTEE VOTING**



Dear Neighbor,

NYS is making applying for an absentee voting application easier for the June 23<sup>rd</sup> primaries due to COVID-19.

Now you will receive the application in the mail.

**HERE'S HOW ABSENTEE VOTING NOW WORKS**

- 1) You will receive an absentee voting application in the mail with a pre-paid envelope.
- 2) Fill it out in blue or black ink.
- 3) Select the box for “**Temporary illness or physical disability.**”
- 4) Make sure to fill in all 8 boxes and sign and date at the bottom.
- 5) Mail ASAP, must be postmarked **no later than June 16th.**

## **NOW WHAT HAPPENS?**

- 1) Look out for your ballot in the mail.
- 2) Fill in all bubbles with blue or black ink.
- 3) Mail the ballot back to your BOE, postmarked **no later than June 22<sup>nd</sup>.**

**If you change your mind and decide to vote in-person, simply don't send in your ballot. You can still go to the polls to vote.**

4) You can also print the application and fill it out by hand with blue or black ink and mail or email it.
