

O'Mara and Palmesano: One week to go! Keep voting for The Glen as America's 'Best NASCAR Track'

Watkins Glen, N.Y., June 29—With one week to go in the voting, State Senator Tom O'Mara (R,C,I-Big Flats) and Assemblyman Phil Palmesano (R,C,I-Corning) are encouraging area residents to keep voting for Watkins Glen International (WGI) in USA Today's 10 Best online Readers' Choice competition to decide America's "Best NASCAR Track."

In a joint statement, O'Mara and Palmesano said, "Let's run hard in these final laps and keep voting for Watkins Glen International as America's 'Best NASCAR Track.' It's an opportunity to keep the Finger Lakes region on the national map and to demonstrate regional pride in The Glen as a favorite destination for visitors from across the country, a cornerstone of our leading tourism industry, and a driving force for charity, community service, and economic development."

The area legislators stressed that anyone can vote once a day, every day, on every Internet-capable device they have until the contest closes on Monday, July 6, at noon.
