ALBANY, NY—"I am thrilled the New York State Senate has passed the START (Survivors of Trafficking Attaining Relief Together) Act for the first time. The START Act truly gives survivors the fresh start they deserve—improving access to employment opportunities, improving access to appropriate immigration legal remedies, and helping break cycles of trauma for thousands of survivors across our state."
